

## **Impressive Performances in Overnight Stakes**

Mechanic Susie wins 6th straight, Crowds getting bigger, Danelson recovering

It didn't take master trainer Murray Duncan long to get his superstar mare Burrow Down back on track once she arrived from Alberta. After an odd shipping-related dull

performance in the Escape Clause Stakes on August 24, the real Burrow Down showed up in the Coral Prospect Stakes on Monday.

Owned by Gerald Babchishin, the 5-year-old daughter of Cigar Mile Handicap (G1) winner Connect had run second and third in stakes at Century Mile before arriving back in Winnipeg, where she truly loves it. Her Escape Clause Stakes was an aberration, and after stalking hard-trying former claimer Jj's American Diva to the final turn in the Coral Prospect, jockey Rachaad Knights found the real Burrow Down loose and it was over quickly. She took over in mid turn and drew off to win by four lengths.

Burrow Down is now 8-for-9 at Assiniboia Downs with multiple stakes wins and career earnings of \$211,632 US. All eight of her wins have come at Assiniboia Downs.

On Tuesday evening in the Nephrite Overnight Stakes, it was trainer Steve Keplin Jr.'s time to shine with former \$12,500 claimer Exacting, and shine he did thanks to a cagey ride by jockey Sven Balroop.

Sent off at almost 4-1, Exacting tracked pacesetter Glava from the outside to the final turn and made a quick move to take over midway through the turn. He then gave his rivals the slip as he opened up a 4 ½-length lead in the stretch, and held on to win by half a length over Blazing Bo, who was trying for his third stakes win in a row. And it was only a neck back to Big Nick in third, who also ran his best race. Without the slippery move, Exacting might not have held on over these two, who gave it everything they had in the stretch.

Owned by Drop'en Racing, James Keplin and Parker Wallette, Exacting had previously finished second and eighth in the R J Speers Memorial and Manitoba Mile respectively, behind Blazing Bo, but there was no denying the 5-year-old Ghostzapper gelding on Tuesday.



The summer crowds continue to grow, and on Wednesday evening our fabulous fans got a double whammy for their money, as Manitoba-bred Mechanic Susie won her sixth race in a row for trainer Elton Dickey and Gee I'm Foxy made it three stakes wins in a row in the \$50,000 Osiris Stakes.

Mechanic Susie (Nonios-Quantum Mechanics by Einstein) was moving up in class in the first race on Monday, after winning the restricted Distaff Stakes, but she brought her big heart with her and outdueled a game Zorina to win by half a length under jockey Antonio Whitehall.

Purchased for only \$1,000 at the local <u>CTHS Manitoba Yearling Sale</u>, Mechanic Susie has now earned \$111,446 US from a record of 8-3-3 in 15 starts for ownership partners Dickey, Tom Payne, and breeder Larry Falloon, and the 4-year-old filly is far from done.

The same could be said for 2-year-old filly Gee I'm Foxy, who is just getting started for trainer Jared Brown and owner Railside Stable. The talented daughter of Del Mar Futurity (G1) winner Klimt made it look easy in the \$50,000 Osiris Stakes on Wednesday after pressing the pace four-wide. When asked to go by jockey Ronald Ali in mid turn, she accelerated to the lead and drew off to win by 2 ½-lengths.

The Osiris was the third stakes win in a row for Gee I'm Foxy, who had previously won the Debutante and Graduation Stakes, and she is now 3-for-4 here after finishing second in her debut, with earnings of \$70,263 US.

On a sad-but-looking-better note, all-time leading ASD trainer Gary Danelson is on the road to recovery in a Grand Forks hospital after a run-in with one of his favourite horses, Kate's Princess. Kate wheeled around in the stall and knocked Danelson over last week, breaking his hip.

Danelson's partner Bonnie McCrory drove him to the hospital, where he had a new ball placed in his hip joint. He then got a urinary infection followed by a touch of pneumonia, but by the sounds of it, it's going to take a lot more than that to stop him.

Danelson, who turned 87 on Wednesday, was in good spirits on Thursday speaking from his hospital bed, and he says he hopes to be back at ASD in about 10 days. He was thankful for Monique Goulet, Will Tourangeau, groom Ulrich Bell, agent Tim Gardiner and exercise rider Garfield Dunkley, who have been looking after all his horse-related tasks while he's been laid up.

## **Top NFL Picks by TravyFootball**

**2024/2025 Season preview:** Finally! Another NFL season is nearly upon us and I couldn't be happier. With the Chiefs and Ravens set to kickoff next Thursday, I thought I would do a preview column of a few things to keep an eye on during this upcoming year.



- 1. Aaron Rodgers Jets debut (for real this time): Rodgers' season was cut short last year due to a torn Achilles Tendon in the season opener. After working his way back from that, the hype for how far he can take this team is starting to gather steam, some even have them making it to the Super Bowl. I have reservations about a 40-year-old man not named Tom Brady, coming off a serious injury, leading anyone to the Super Bowl, but I guess we shall see.
- 2. Can the Chiefs remain the team to beat? I put myself through torture re-watching the Super Bowl every now and then wondering what went wrong for San Fran. The

Twenty years ago, on August 2, 2004, Royalty Boy drew out from the 1/16th pole to win the 56th edition of the Derby for Owners Antingham, Propp & Gromoff, trainer B. Phelan and jockey Real Simard. Mott-trained colt tops field of seven in Sept. 1 stakes on final weekend at Saratoga


