







A Snapshot in Time by Track Historian Bob Gates



On September 2, 1979 seven horses went to postward for the 50th running of the Winnipeg Futurity. Pictured above was one of the local hopefuls, #5 Mr. Macho with Jacques DesAutels in the saddle, as they made their way to the starting gate. Mr. Macho was still a growing boy and was no match for eastern shipper Gemellion on that day, finishing fifth, but a tremendous career awaited him as he grew into one of the finest distance runners at the Downs. He later went on to win the King Edward Gold Cup Handicap at Woodbine. The classy runner also finished second in the Niagara Handicap (G3) at Fort Erie, and fourth in both the Arlington Handicap (G1) at Arlington Park and the San Luis Obispo Handicap (G2) at Santa Anita. 
