### History:

The concept of Winners was developed as a result of a prominent U.S. Horse owner. Backstretch workers at North American tracks were living in deplorable conditions and a number of good employees were being lost to drug and alcohol abuse.

As a result the Ryan foundation was created and offered matching funds to any racetrack that wished to take up the cause and better the lives of those who gave more attention and concern to the horses entrusted to their care than to their own health.

At Assiniboia Downs Mr. Dan Williams, the former executive director of the MHRC, became aware of this funding and applied to the foundation for a grant. With the support of the Horsemen's Benevolent Protective Association and a start up grant from the Sill foundation matching the Ryan foundation grant, Winners was born.

### Who we are:

Winners exists to help individuals and their families find solutions to problems relating to addictions and other life—issues that may interfere with healthy living.

We focus our efforts on awareness and prevention in order to help foster a healthy environment on the race track.

We provide support to anyone on the race track seeking it. Because Winners Foundation is a "Place for Help," our services are readily accessible and anonymous.

We are made up of a Counselor, Athletic Therapist and committee of volunteers.

# What do the programs cost persons using Winners Foundation Services?

Winners Foundation is a non-for-profit organization, therefore any costs incurred by people using the program are either minimal (only covering cost of goods) or free.
