# **Handicapping: Fun With Artificial Intelligence (AI)**

Could AI reduce your handicapping time? Imagine the possibilities.



Horse handicapping. With Al.

Wouldn't it be nice if you could get AI to do all the heavy lifting when you're handicapping the races? AI is getting smarter by the second, and it can now read PDFs of Past Performances. It also understands most if not all basic handicapping concepts.

We asked the \$20-a-month paid version of <u>Claude.ai</u> to handicap <u>Race 4</u> at Woodbine on Friday, November 15, and you can see the results below. We don't 100 percent agree with the output but it's decent considering we've barely taught the AI anything about handicapping yet.

Al is only as smart as the person training it when you first start prompting it for answers but as it produces results it can be further tweaked to provide more detailed answers, and you can feed the actual results back into it so that it can learn where it was right or wrong.

We prompted AI to analyze a race for basic factors such as speed, class, and pace. We also asked it to identify contenders, suggest longshots and value plays, and offer a basic wagering strategy. A more detailed prompt might include your personal favourite handicapping angles and your own specific knowledge about the track you're playing.

The prompt we used, and the output the Al produced, for <u>Race 4</u> on Friday at Woodbine, are included below. After the race has run, we'll tell Claude.ai what the actual results were, and right or wrong, it will learn from those results.

Al is going to get better and better at predictive analytics such as those required for handicapping a horse race. There are already numerous apps that provide Al horse racing

picks which are based on probabilities, but just imagine if you could train the AI to handicap a race in your style, and then apply it to hundreds of races a day. Would it be like, 'Where's the wheel barrow? © 'Not just yet, but...

Imagine the possibilities.


The race sets up well for a closer like Ethnic Soul who has been steadily improving and should get the right pace setup. Shamateur offers value if able to control moderate fractions, while Zakhari could improve with equipment change. The suggested betting strategy allows coverage of the most likely scenarios while focusing on the best value opportunities.

Broncos over Falcons (Sunday afternoon): Those poor Broncos. Just when it looked like the Chiefs' winning streak was coming to an end, the very rare blocked field goal dashed those hopes on the last play of the game. Even though they lost, Denver has been playing good football as of late, led by rookie quarterback, Bo Nix. He didn't get off to the greatest start this season, but over five games he has accounted for seven touchdowns and only two interceptions. He also has the ability to use his legs, racking up 185 yards on the ground over that same five game span.



The Falcons did what the Falcons do every season last week, sucker people into thinking they're a good team, and then go out and lay a stinker against a team they should easily beat, in this case it was the Saints. If they want to be taken seriously, they can't play down to the competition. Saints interim coach Darren Rizzi might have had the quote of the week: "This is how my day started; I get down to the Superdome. I go into the head coach's locker room, which I've never used before. 



Longshot listed at 10-1 faces 11 rivals at Woodbine on Saturday




Artie's Storm wins at Woodbine. (Michael Burns/Woodbine)

12 of the most expensive Canadian-breds to sell at auction, an unofficial report




Wonder Gadot earned a million and brought \$2 million at auction. (Michael Burns photo)


